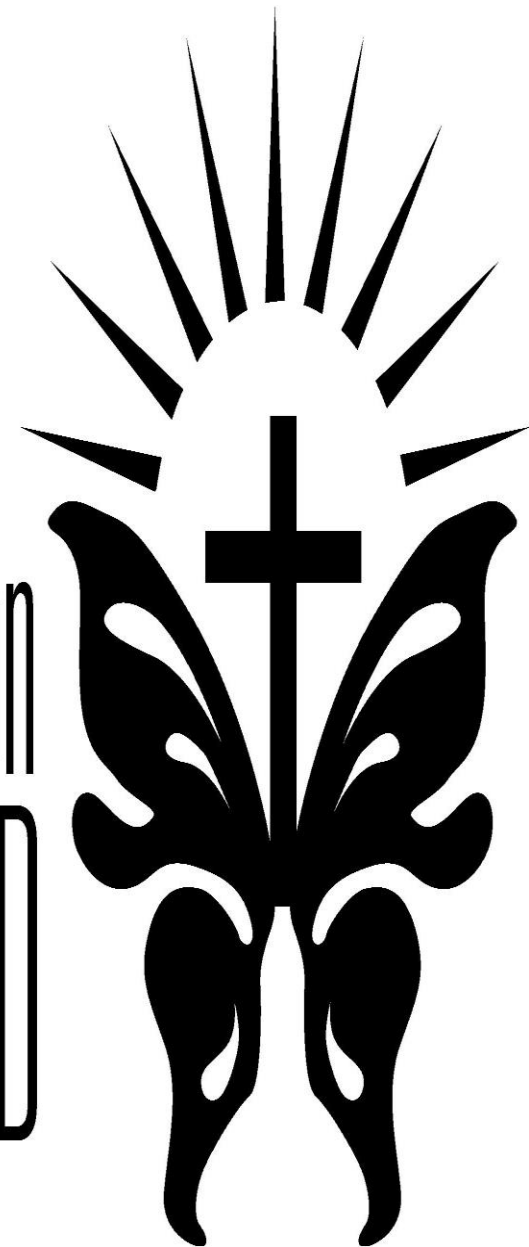
We believe we have been called to reveal that God is real and relevant in people's lives and in our community. We strive to do this by...
