- **Boxed Potatoes, Canned Potatoes, Canned Corn, Chili, Canned Fruit, Mac & Cheese, Hamburger Helper, Canned Pasta, Spaghetti Sauce, Canned Chicken, Vegetable Soup, Chunky Soup (with 7 grams of protein), Canned Beef Stew, Spam, Toilet Paper.**
