The Mission & Faith Group is collecting non-perishable food items (check expiration date) to help fight hunger in our local community. All food collected will be donated to the Joy Pantry. The Pantry's most commonly requested items include the following:

- Boxed Potatoes, Canned Potatoes, Canned Corn, Chili, Canned Fruit, Mac & Cheese, Hamburger Helper, Canned Pasta, Spaghetti Sauce, Canned Chicken, Vegetable Soup, Chunky Soup (with 7 grams of protein), Canned Beef Stew, Spam, Toilet Paper.

Advent Bible Study



ADVENT BIBLE STUDY: Incarnation - Join us this season for an Advent Bible study titled, *Incarnation*. This study is based on Adam Hamilton's book with the same title. In this study, we will explore the incarnation of Jesus, of God becoming flesh, here on earth and what that means for us. We will explore seven different names of Jesus, how they have been understood and what they mean to us. We will rediscover the significance of Christmas.

A couple questions we will be exploring are:

Why would God come to us in Jesus?

What was the purpose of the Incarnation?

How are we meant to respond to the Incarnation, to God's coming to us in Jesus, today? (Hamilton, p. 10).

Here are the dates we will be meeting for this four week study: Thursdays at 7 pm on November 19; December 3; December 10; December 17.
