# Fall Food Gathering (November 7th through November 21st)

Other potential items to donate: boxed potatoes, canned corn, canned fruit, mac & cheese, Hamburger Helper, canned pasta, spaghetti sauce, canned chicken, vegetable soup, chunky soup and toilet paper.


