The Mission & Faith Group is collecting non-perishable food items (check expiration date) to help fight hunger in our community. All food collected will be donated to Joy Pantry in Jonestown.

The pantry's most commonly requested items include the following: canned potatoes (not yams), stuffing mix, canned carrots, canned mixed veggies, fruit cocktail, applesauce, frosting for cakes, canned Spam, canned pasta, canned chili and canned stew.

Other potential items to donate: boxed potatoes, canned corn, canned fruit, mac & cheese, Hamburger Helper, canned pasta, spaghetti sauce, canned chicken, vegetable soup, chunky soup and toilet paper.

Donated items can be left at the Food Gathering station from November 7th thru 21st. As always, if you prefer not to shop for items, a monetary donation can be placed in the plate at the gathering station and team members will shop for items.
