Dear Friends in Christ,

Salvation belongs to the LORD; your blessing be on your people! Selah (Psalm 3:8, ESV)

Shout with joy to God, all the earth!
Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious! Say to God, "
How awesome are your deeds!
So great is your power that your enemies cringe before you. All the earth bows down to you; they sing praise to you, they sing praise to you, they sing praise to Your name. Selah (Psalm 66:1-4, NIV)

Bless the Lord! The God of our salvation supports us day after day!
Selah (Psalm 68:19, CEB)

Summer is coming to an end and fall is upon us. Our schedules have changed; the weather is changing; the leaves are beginning to fall. It is a change of season and, at such times as these, we should take time to practice the pause. In the midst of change, there is uncertainty. With the change of schedules, there is busyness. We are accustomed to continue to work hard and to accomplish everything on our "to do" lists, while sacrificing other things that are important to us. In this season, practice the pause. Take time to be still and to know He is God. Take time to rest and to breathe. Take time to read a couple extra Scripture verses.

Selah. This is an important word that is written in the Bible seventy-four times. It is written seventy-one times in Psalms and three times in Habakkuk. In many of the Psalms where the word "Selah" is written, the Psalm was written to the choirmaster or director of music. This indicates that Selah could be written similar to musical notation where a rest might be in the song. When there is a rest written in the music, it tells the musician

to pause; to stop. There is power in the music because of the rests in it. Without the rests the music would be busy and would sound all jumbled. Selah is telling us the same thing – to pause, to rest. There is power in our lives when we take time to rest.

In a time of change in our lives — whether it be because of the change of seasons, or change in work, or making decisions, we need to take time to rest in the goodness of God; to seek renewal through Christ Jesus our Lord. Spend more time in prayer and spend time listening to God. Cry out to Him your needs and concerns; cry out to Him your praises; take time to listen to God. Pause and look around at the beauty of creation that surrounds us. Listen for the joyous sounds that surround us. For, through it all, there is goodness and glory. The grace of God will be revealed, even through the difficult times.

As fall approaches and as schedules change, let us be intentional on spending time in prayer, be intentional on reading the Word of God, be intentional on being the hands and feet of Jesus wherever it is we are, be intentional on being the church together, as the people called Trinity. Breathe in the goodness of God and exhale your stress; breathe in the grace of God and exhale your worry and so on. Take time to pause. We serve an amazing God who is ever so gracious, loving, and merciful. Reflect on the glory of the Lord and be thankful. Praise Him for He is a good, good God. He is God Almighty! Praise be to God! Be blessed this day and always.


OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

(Remember no candy, drink mixes, liquids, toothpaste or glass items.)






