From Pastor Deanna's Pen ~

Dear Friends in Christ,

Welcome 2023! 2022 is now finished and we have begun a new year. The time is now to focus on goals and growing in faith. How is it with your soul? The year 2022 may have brought many blessings and many challenges to you. Maybe you know something about grief, worry and anxiety about unexpected changes, about unwelcome surprises and even wonderful surprises. Maybe you know something about goodness and happiness. Many of us have experienced the whole gamut this past year. Some are still pondering what it all means and who they are through the midst of it all.

Here's the thing that you must know and remember...God is good! Our God is an awesome God who is ever so gracious and all loving. Our God is steadfast and faithful. Our God is the same today as He was yesterday as He will be tomorrow. Our God is ever present with each and every one of us. Our God is Emmanuel - God with us. That is who we celebrate at Christmas – the greatest gift of all - that God sent His one and only Son here to earth to be with us and to show us how to live a life that is full and abundant, filled with His grace and mercy. Through Christ, we have meaning and purpose. Through Christ, we have hope and promise. So, how are you celebrating Jesus? How are you taking time to pause to thank God for being ever present with you? For, no matter what it is you are going through, God is with you. Isaiah 43:1-2 says, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you."

Truth be told, the storms of life will come. We will pass through waters. The winds will come; the rain will come; and through it all, you may wonder what to do, along with so many other questions. In those times, remember that God is with

you. He will give you strength to endure. For God has named you; He has claimed you; He has redeemed you in the name of Jesus. You belong to God. But it is in the difficult times, when we need to draw closer and closer to God and when we need to be in community with the church. It is also in those times when you need to be certain that you are rooted and grounded in faith.

There is a children's song that speaks to this truth...about the wiseman who built his house upon the rock, but when the rains came - when the floods came, the house stood firm and steadfast. Whereas, the "foolish man" who built his house upon the sand ended up tumbling down when the rains and when the floods came. Where have you built your house? Is it upon the rock or upon the sand? Think about that and ponder that. If your house is upon the sand, then its time to move your house to be up on the rock. If your house is on the rock, there will be times, when it feels as though it is on the sand. No matter where your house is built, we need to be and to stay rooted in the love and grace of God. We need to stay rooted in the Word of God. We need to be rooted in our faith by being the body of Christ together – by being the hands and feet of Jesus – as the church, as we serve together in ministry to remain rooted and as we share the love of Jesus with others – through our service, deeds, words, and very presence.

Our theme this year is "Rooted" based upon this Scripture passage:

Colossians 2:6-7

So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.
