In the past, I've led confirmation classes in the fall and spring, with confirmation occurring at the Easter Vigil, the Saturday night before Easter Sunday. I think 8th or 9th grade is an ideal time for confirmation, but classes are generally open to anyone 6th grade or older. I especially love having whole families attend classes together.

2023/24 NLSD RELEASE TIME PROGRAM - Are you looking for an opportunity to impact local youth with the Gospel? The Northern Lebanon Ministerium is preparing to launch the NLSD Elementary Release Time **Program** on Thursday, November 2, 2023 (10-11am).


