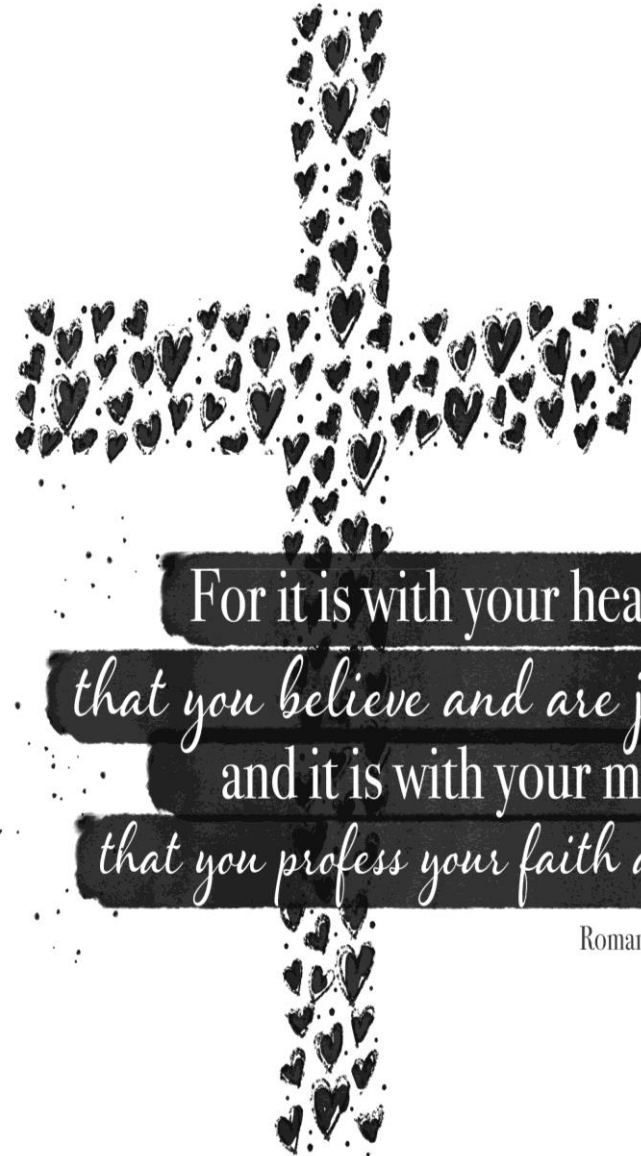
Vision Statement ~
